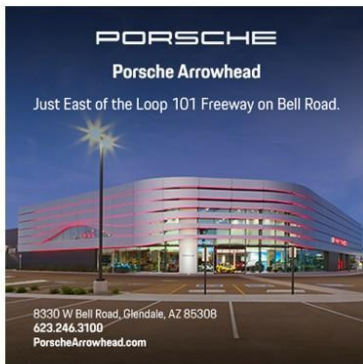
AWARD WINNING AZM REGION WEBSITE KEEPS YOU IN THE KNOW!
